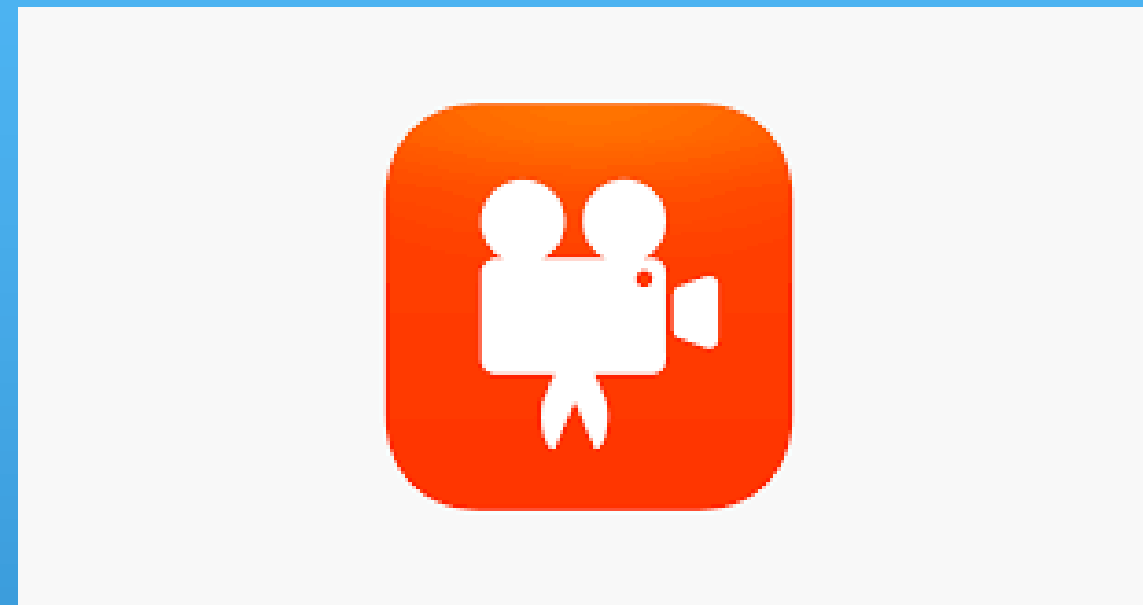

Option 1: Take one long video



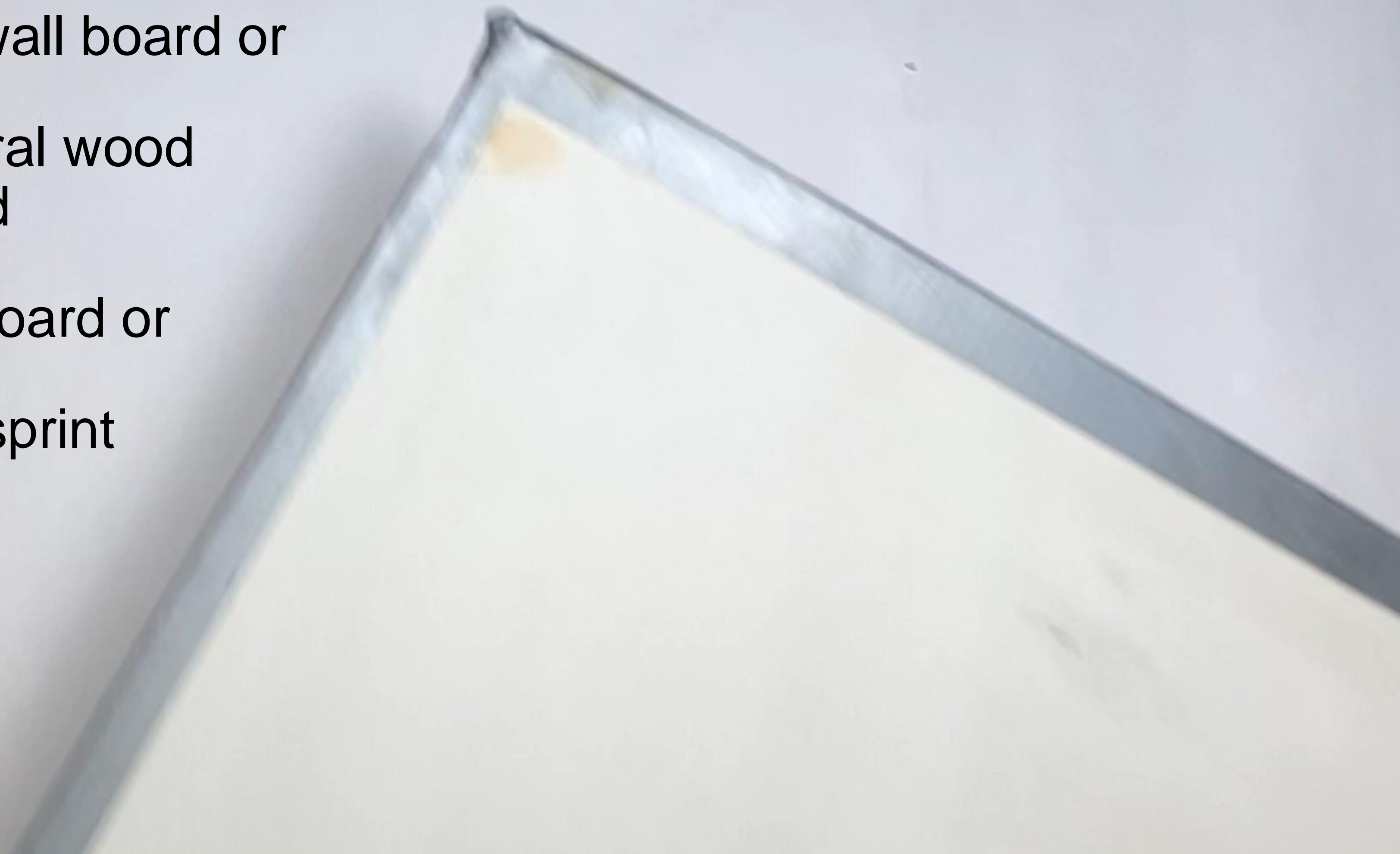
Option 2: Create shorter videos

Disadvantage: Set up every time you record

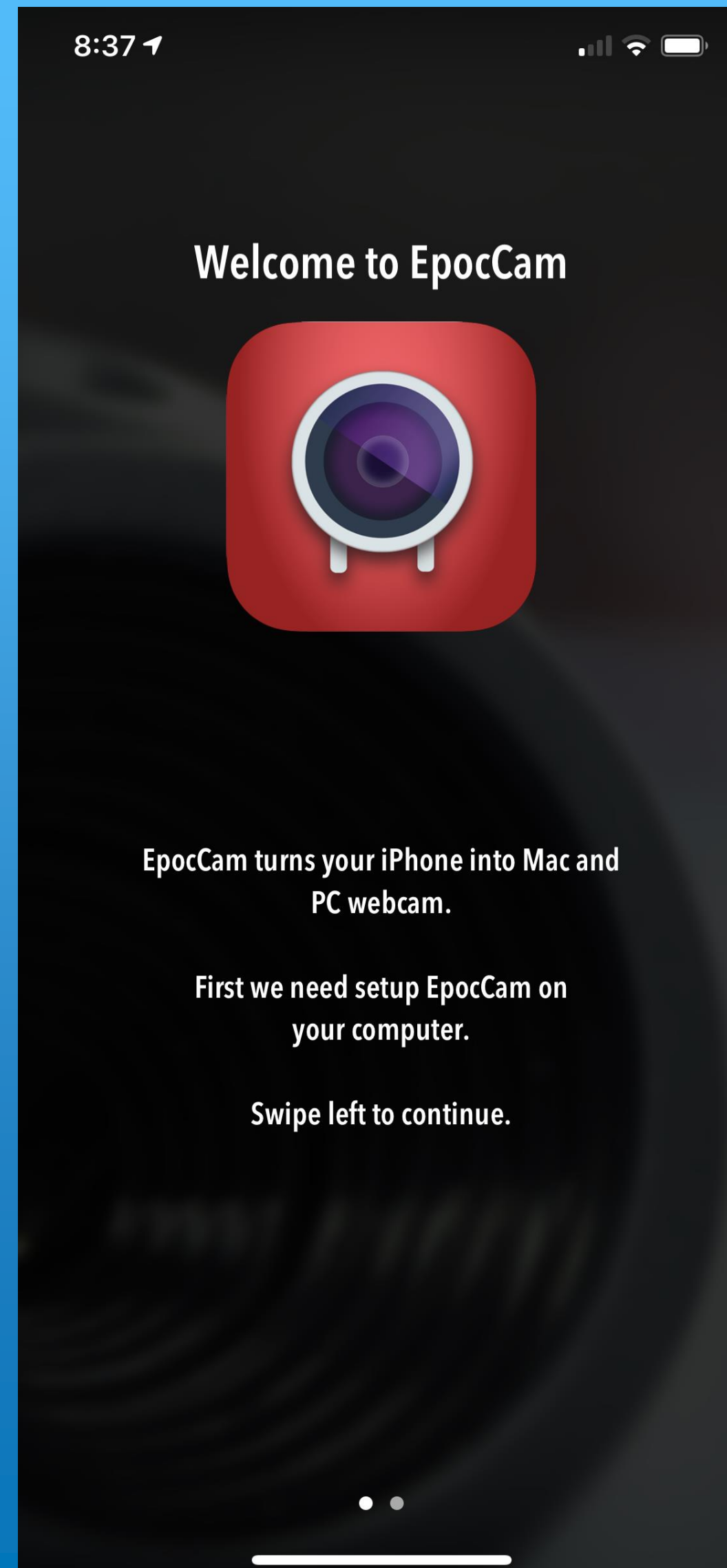
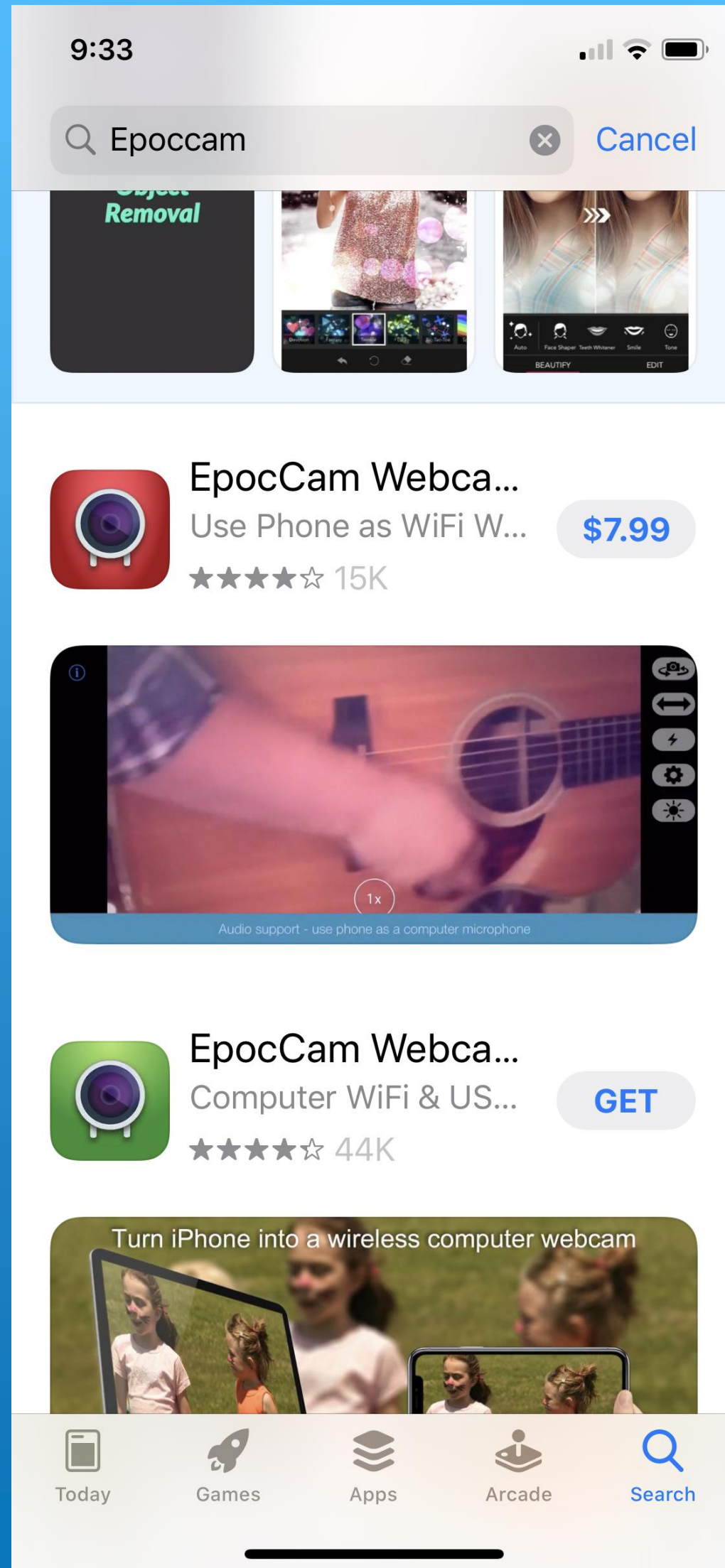
Option 2: Webcam

Disadvantage: Screen record

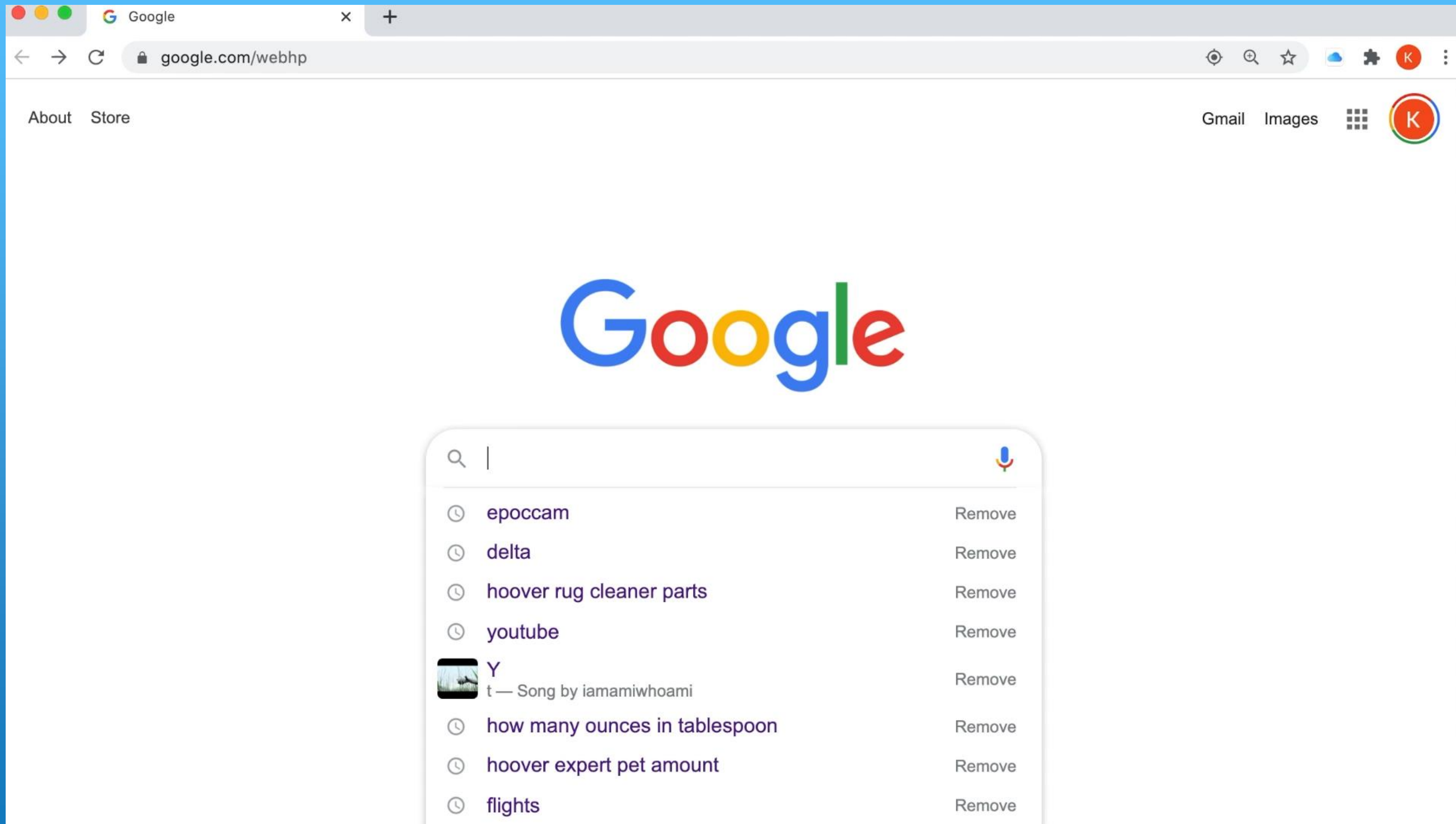

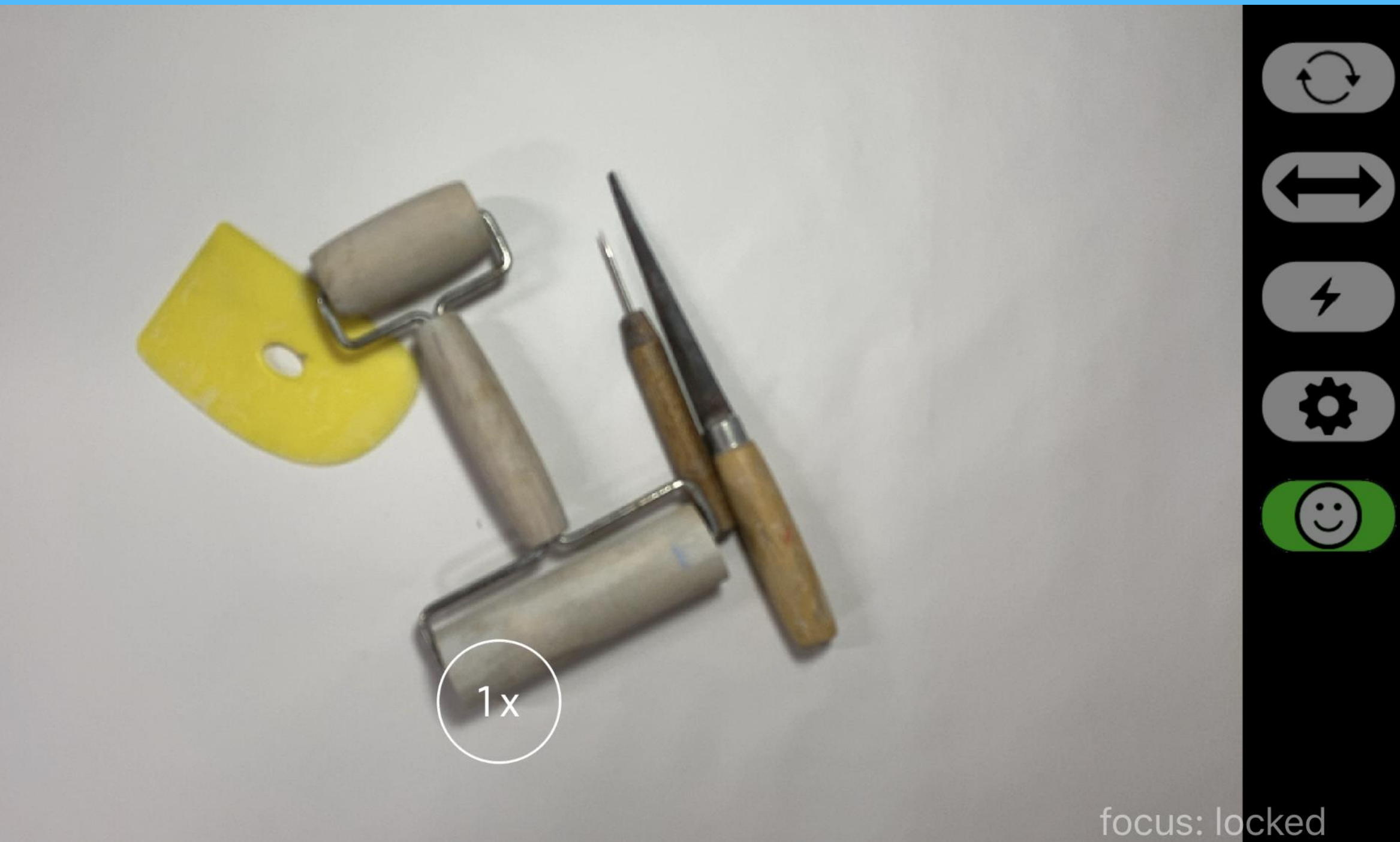


Install EpocCam on your computer from the Kinoni website





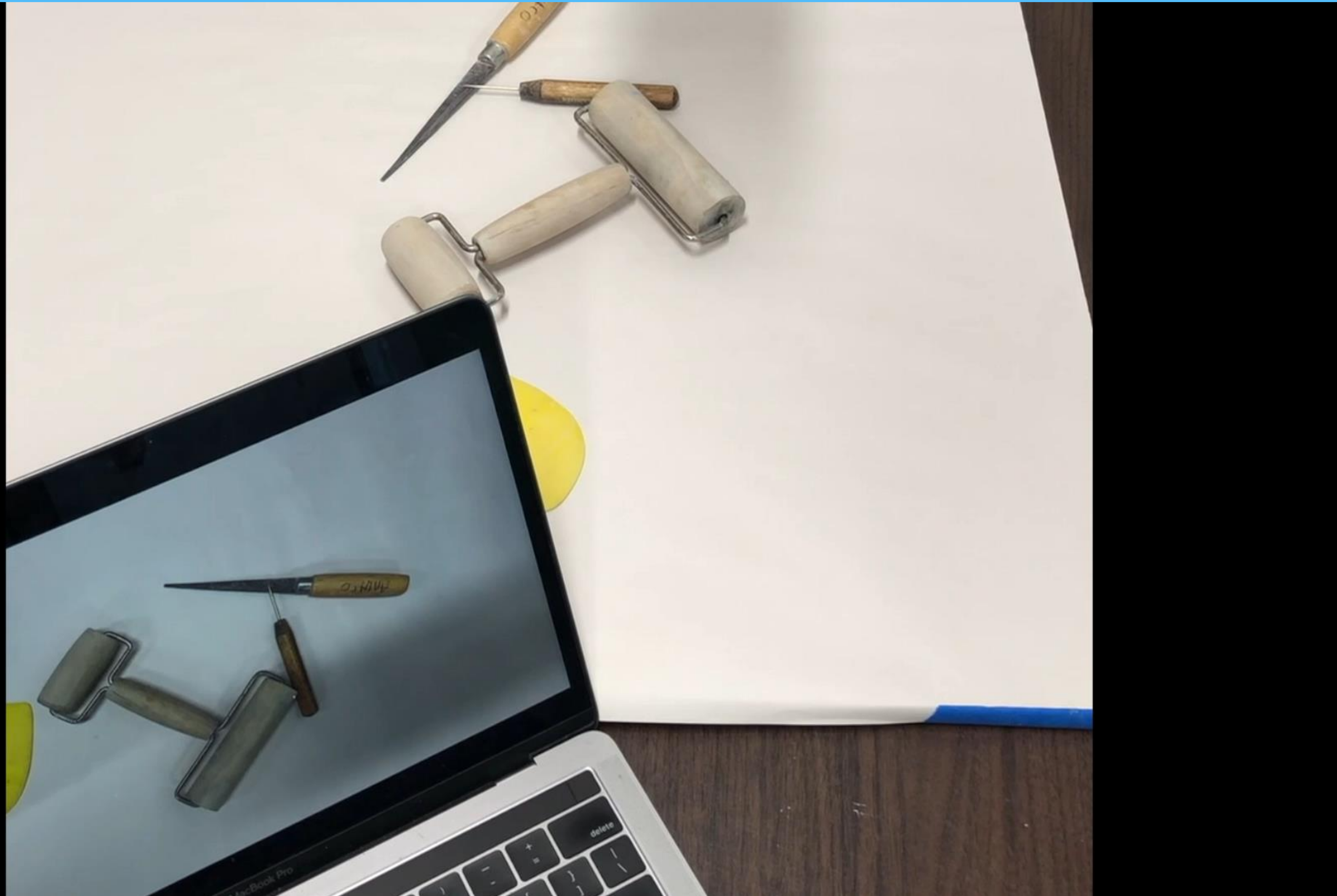
Open EpocCam on your cell phone

- Green screen



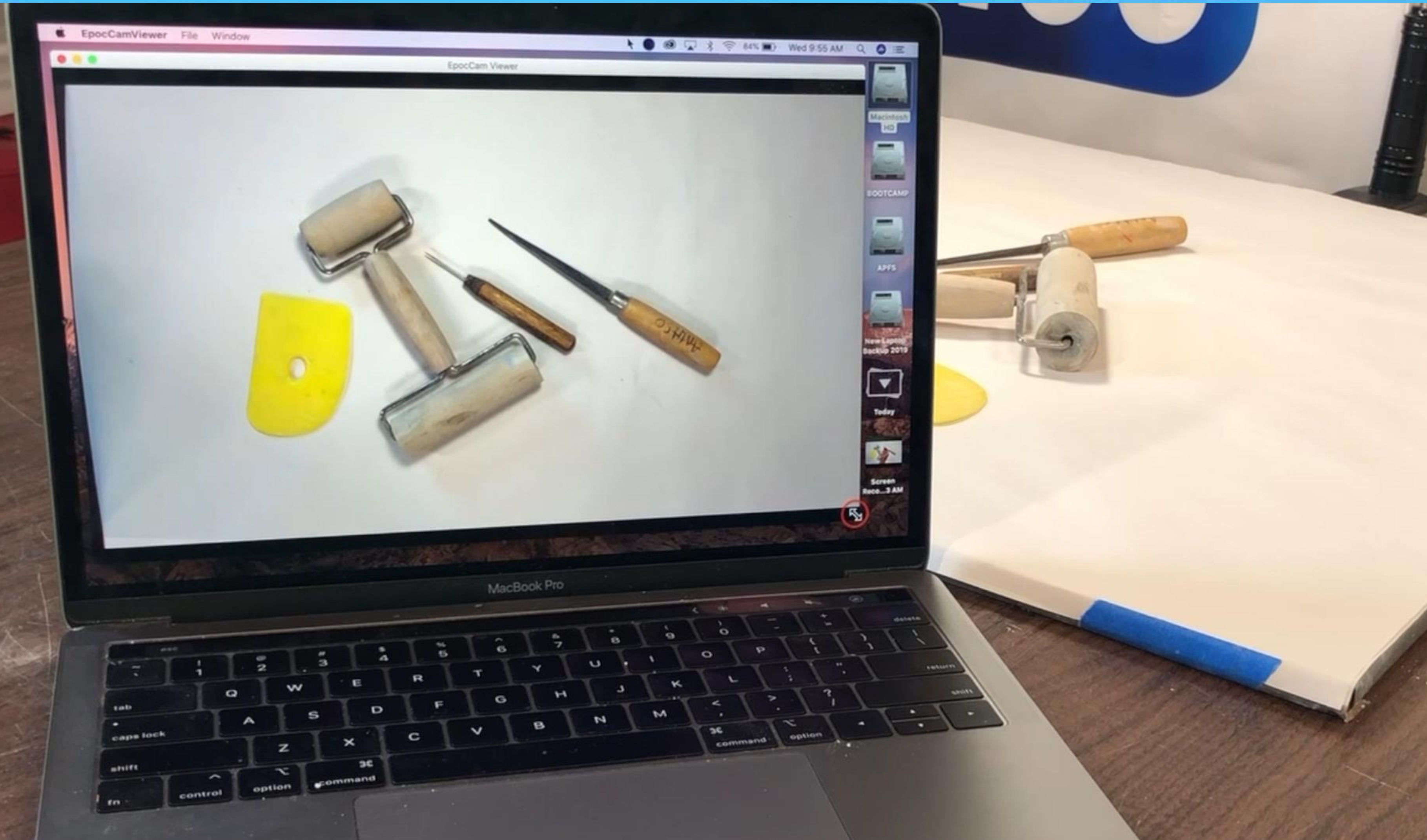
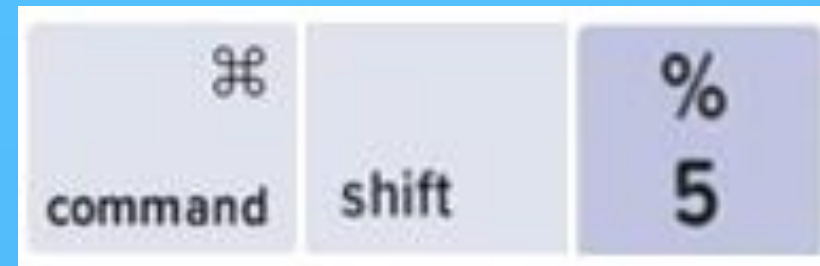

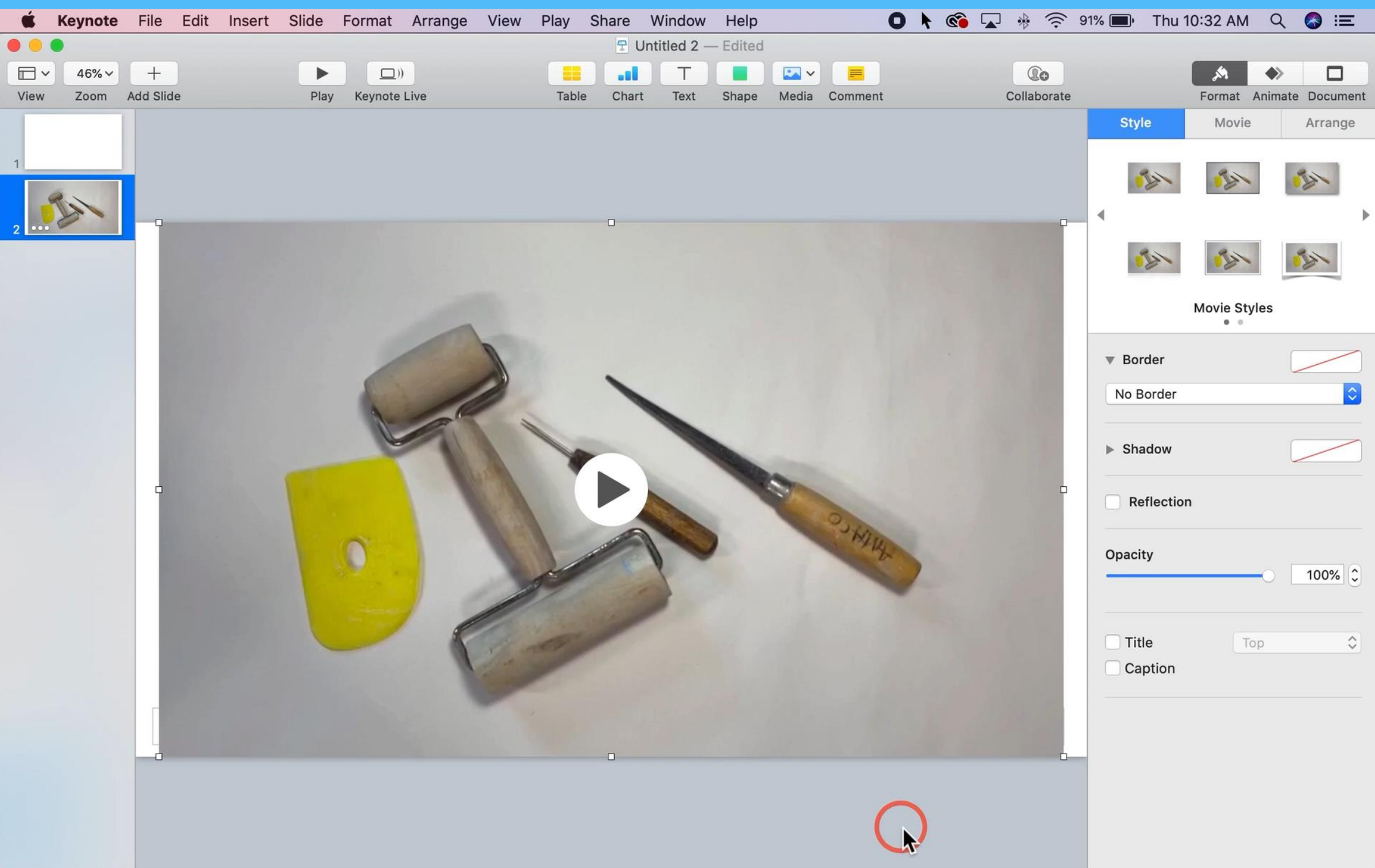

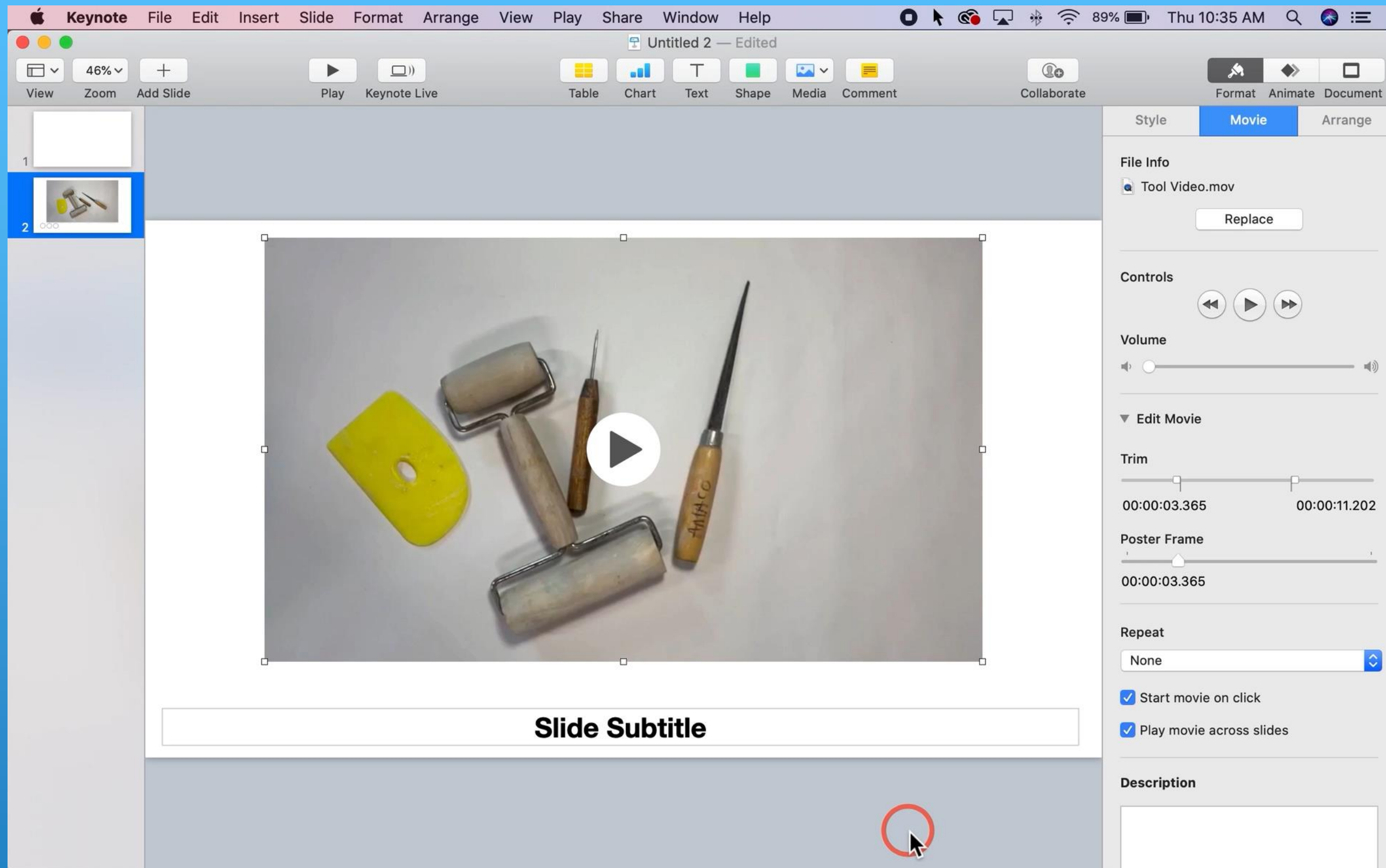

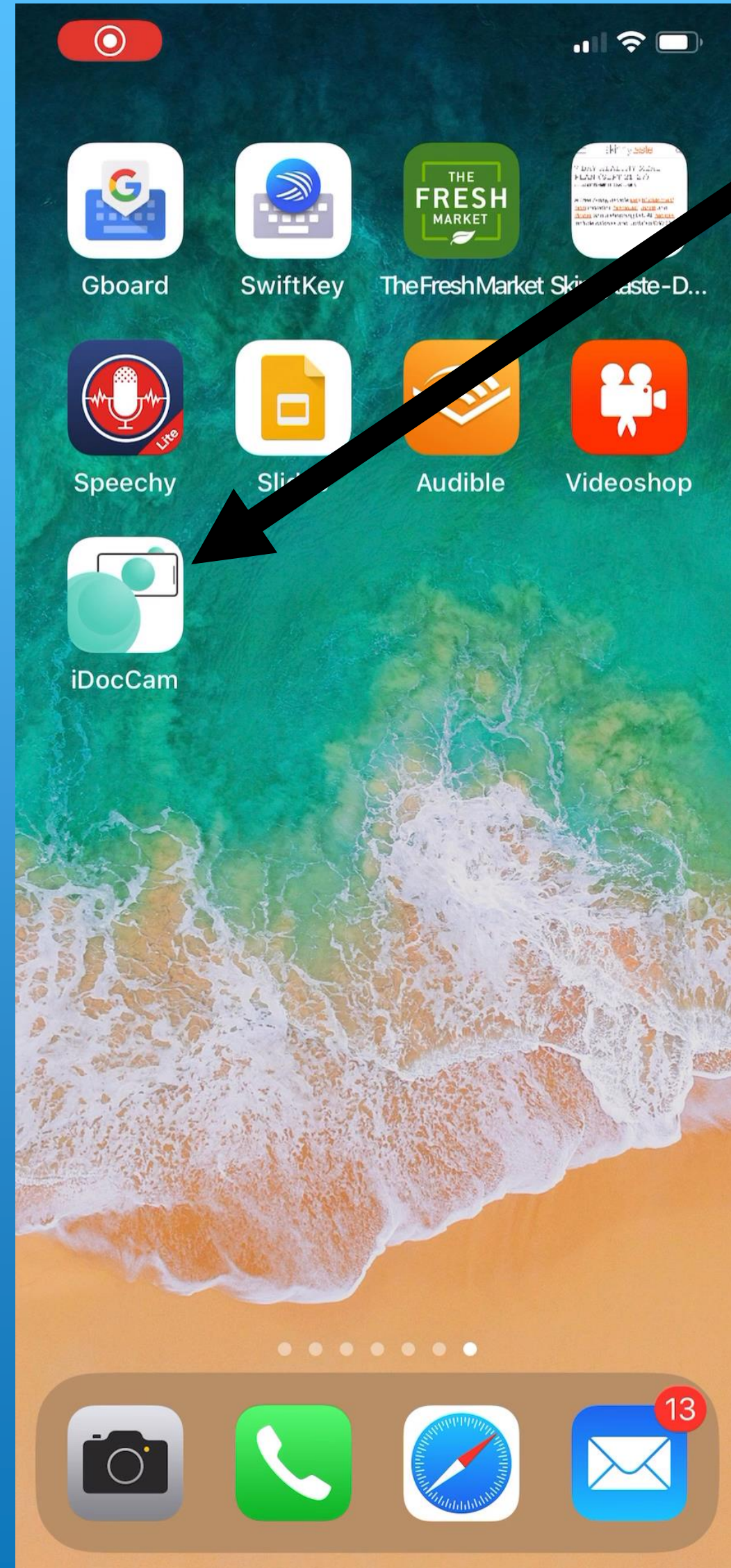


Overlap shapes to 'crop' the video

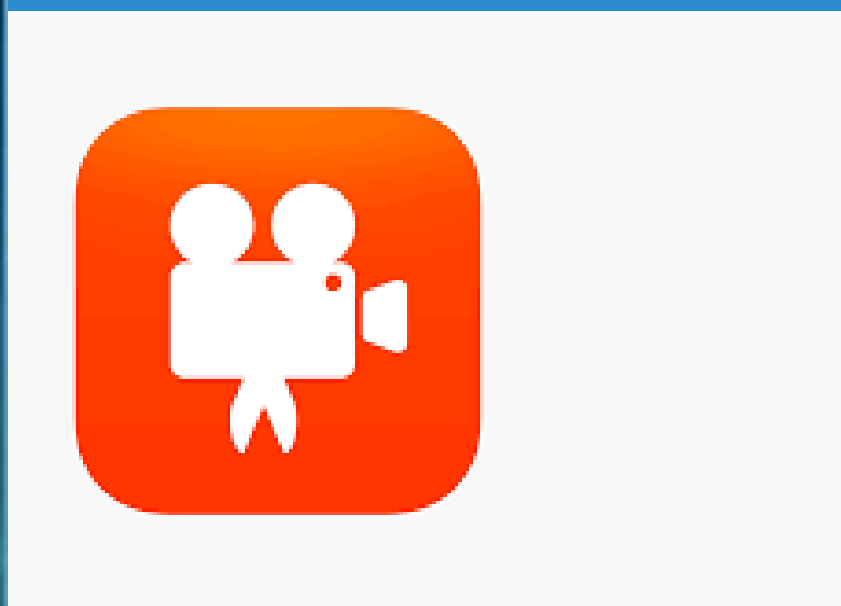
